

A newly redesigned and improved World War II Commemorative Weekend is in store for both participants and the public this March at Dade Battlefield Historic State Park! Beginning right at the front gate where an MP guard carefully monitors guest entries, virtually everything visitors encounter is designed to transport them back to 1944, when the park was actually the encampment site of the 622nd Signal Air Warning Company.

Among other opportunities to experience both military and civilian culture during the war years will be:

- Allied and Axis encampments as busy locations in which activities are explained and questions encouraged.
- Children and adults will be able to try on parts of uniforms and civilian clothing for photo ops.
- Vehicles and marchers will pass in review several times each day, accompanied by narration and music.
- USO-style music and comedy acts will be performed all through the day at pre-announced times.
- Voluntary opportunities for gathering military intelligence with prizes offered for successful mission completions.
